PACKAGING, LABELING AND WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS

Problem(s):

There are no packaging, labeling or weight requirements for commercial sale of RX Cannabis.

Solution(s):

Establish basic packaging and labeling requirements for the sale of RX Cannabis.

Possible Support:

Consumers, Dr's, Pharmaceutical, NORML, Law Enforcement,

Possible Opposition:

Consumers, Dr's, Pharmaceutical, NORML, Law Enforcement, Patients

Arguments In Support:

- 1) All commercial drugs must be properly marked and packaged for proper consumer, and RX Cannabis should be also;
- 2) The concepts listed below are what we consider to be the "basics" that we believe that RX Cannabis "users" are entitled to.

Arguments In Opposition:

- 1) This is work for the Federal Government;
- 2) Marijuana should be sold in any amount or fashion a cannabis club desires.

Language: Concepts outlined below

On package:

- 1) Each package must declare whether it is organic or chemically enhanced RX Cannabis;
- 2) What the specific ingredients in the package are;
- 3) Storage instructions;
- 4) Weight - The Minimum package size for commercial sale is one ounce;
- 5) Disposal of unused portion instructions;
- 6) Moisture content.

Type of Packaging:

- 1) Hermetically sealed and Germ Free;
- 2) Stored in refrigerated system.

Packaging Facilities:

- 1) All packaging facilities and equipment must comply with current weights and measures standards.
